

Jerusalem Center may reopen

Brigham Young University plans to reopen its Jerusalem Center in January, provided safety concerns in the Holy Land do not cause another delay.

BYU announced in June that it would reopen the center this fall, but a month later canceled the plan because of the escalating violence between Israelis and Palestinians.

BYU issued a release Tuesday saying that it will open 44 positions to students to study in Jerusalem when the winter semester begins in January. Students already enrolled at the Provo campus can apply between Oct. 23 and Nov. 3.
